
Edward Benvas, Conductor



He is Professor of Oboe at SIU Carbondale, Music Director of the Southern Illinois Symphony, New Chicago Chamber Orchestra and the Southern Illinois Music Festival. The Illinois Council of Orchestras named him Conductor of the Year. He has guest conducted orchestras in 12 states and Europe. Of one recent appearance, the Copley Chicago Newspapers wrote: "Edward Benyas' clear directions from the podium helped create a night of true magic." His conducted repertoire includes nearly 400 works, including a dozen world

premieres and over a dozen complete operas and ballets.

Clifton Evans, Conductor



Clifton Evans currently serves as Director of Orchestras, Associate Professor of Music, Graduate Advisor, and String Area Coordinator at the University of Texas at Arlington. He is also Founder and Artistic Director of the Arlington Youth Symphony. Dr. Evans has enjoyed a conducting career that has taken him to Hong Kong, England, China, Austria, the Czech Republic and throughout the United States. Most recently, he was honored to conduct the Fort Worth Symphony at the Main Street Arts Festival. His

upcoming schedule includes a return engagement with the American Festival for the Arts Conservatory Orchestra in Houston in the summer of 2015.

Born in Trieste, and graduated in Violin in 1994 at Music Conservatory "G.Tartini" of Trieste, played in the O.G.I. Orchestra Giovanile Italiana (Italian Youth Orchestra - founded in 1980 by Piero Farulli) in 1992 under conductors like C.M.Giulini, S.Accardo, G.G.Rath. In 1994-1995 studied Orchestral Conduction in Gorizia with Prof.

Francesco Mander. Violin player in many ensembles, orchestras and in many events in Italy and Europe (Austria, Slovenija, Hrvatia, Czech Rep., Hungaria...). Teacher of Violin and Orchestral Trainer to adult and young musicians and teacher of propedeutical music elements to baby since 1995.

Vasja Legiša, Cello.



Vasja Legiša is winner of numerous awards in international competitions. He performs as soloist and conductor in many countries (England, France, Italy, Austria, Slovenia, Germany, Israel, Switzerland, Spain). In 2005 he plays in the St.Paul Church in London and in the Hanns Eisler Musikhochschule in Berlin, 2009 with the chamber orchestra of the Symphonic Orchestra Hamburg in twenty main cities of Spain. He was artistic director of the Festival »Cello & Music«

from 2000 to 2007. He teaches in Hamburg, at the High School of Music of Caltanissetta in Sicily and since 2010 in Weilheim, where he is permanent conductor of the Weilheim Chamber Orchestra. in 2014 he is acclaimed conducting the Georgisches Kammerorchester Ingolstadt.

She performed with the Ouartet and the Elvsée Ouartet Almus, as a soloist with UK Symphony Orchestra in London with the European Romantic Orchestra, the Ensemble Symphonique de Paris, Chamber Orchestra "Dionysus" ... She is founder of the Trio Botticelli and recorded for Radio Television Belgrade, and for the Radio Suisse Romande. His new CD "Byzantine Mosaic" was released in 2012 with "Naxos" and was featured on CBC Radio Classique, France Music and Radio Suisse Romande.

Massimiliano Donninelli enters upon an international career at very young age. An orchestra that since its founding has become the fulcrum of a series of musical activities devoted mainly to young musicians. Starring concerts and master-classes are only young musicians who are led by renowned experts in the realization of major concert events.

First parts of prestigious orchestras and opera singers of international renown regularly collaborate with the ZAUBERORCHESTRA thereby creating a series of regular meetings, allowing the realization of an International Orchestral and Opera Advanced Academy. The JMIYO and ONGI have been born thanks to "GMI - seat of Verona" in collaboration with the Association "Progetto Mikrokosmos" in Verona and "Associazione Culturale Prisma" of Trieste.
